Sub-Chapter B

State Retirement Program for Employees of Assumption Parish Police Jury

SECTION 22:11. POLICY

It is hereby declared to be the policy and purpose of the Assumption Jury of Napoleonville, Louisiana, to extend the provisions of Act No. 205, Regular Session, Louisiana Legislature of 1952, providing retirement to eligible officers and employees of the Assumption Police Jury of Napoleonville, Louisiana, in pursuance of said policy, and for said purpose, the officers and employees of the Assumption Police Jury of Napoleonville, Louisiana, shall take such action as may be required by applicable State laws or regulations. The coverage of eligible officers and employees shall be retroactive to May 12, 1978. (Ordinance of 8/30/78)

SECTION 22:12. PRESIDENT OF POLICE JURY AUTHORIZED TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH PAROCHIAL EMPLOYEES BOARD

The President of the Assumption Parish Police Jury is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with the Board of Trustees of the Parochial Employees Retirement System to secure coverage of eligible officers and employees as provided in Section 22:1. (Ordinance of 8/30/78)

SECTION 22:13. EMPLOYEE CONTRIBUTIONS; WITHHOLDING FROM WAGES

Withholdings from salaries or wages of officers and employees for the purposes provided in Section 22.1 hereof are hereby and authorized to be made in the amount and at such times as may be required by the Board of Trustees in accordance with Act No. 205 of 1952, and shall be paid over to the Board of Trustees in such amounts and at such times as are designated by State laws and regulations of said Agency. (Ordinance of 8/30/78)

SECTION 22:14. EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS; ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES

Employer contributions and assessment for administrative expenses shall be paid from amounts appropriated for such purposes to the Board of Trustees in accordance with applicable State laws and regulations of said Board of Trustees. (Ordinance of 8/30/78)

SECTION 22:15. BUSINESS MANAGER TO MAINTAIN RECORDS

The Business Manager shall maintain such records and submit such reports as may be required by applicable State laws or regulations of the Board of Trustees. (Ordinance of 8/30/78)

SECTION 22:16. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage. (Ordinance of 8/30/78)
