

CHAPTER 7

FIRE PROTECTION AND PREVENTION

Sub-Chapter A

In General

SECTION 7:1. BONFIRE REGULATIONS

A. It is hereby prohibited for any person, firm, corporation to construct, erect, build or ignite any logs, wood, branches, limbs, or any debris of any nature, description or kind, which may be commonly known as a bonfire within two hundred fifty feet (250') from the boundary line of the property belonging to another.

B. A violation of this Section shall be a misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or imprisonment for not more than five (5) days or both, at the discretion of the court.
